# **Ovidius University – Constanța**



Ovidius University of Constanța is a public higher education institution founded in 1961 and transformed into a comprehensive university in 1990. It has study programs in medical and natural sciences, humanities and engineering, social and economic sciences, law and administrative sciences, theology and arts. Ovidius University of Constanța offers nationally and internationally accredited programs at all three levels of study, the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees offered being recognized in the entire European Union and beyond. With over 15,000 students, of which about 1200 are international, it is the largest university in South-East Romania and the largest university of the European Union at the Black Sea. Ovidius University of Constanța offers bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degree programs in various fields, including medical and natural sciences, humanities, engineering, and social sciences.

## Admission Requirements: Ovidius University Constanta

- > Pass Biology & Chemistry in high school (UK students: A-levels required)
- > English proficiency test (exempt for native speakers or certified proficiency)
- Early application advised (May 11 June 18, and July 26 August 25)
- Required fees include file processing (£100), application (£100), English test (£150 if needed), and enrollment (£100)

## **Courses Available at Ovidius University Constanta**

Ovidius University Constanta offers a 6-year Medicine program taught in English, totaling 360 ECTS credits. Similar to many other universities, the curriculum is divided into two phases: Pre-clinical and Clinical. The initial three years focus on theoretical studies and pre-clinical

training, emphasizing core knowledge and laboratory work. The final three years involve hands-on clinical experience in hospitals, including surgical courses. While there is no graduate entry medicine option, transferring students are welcome. The university is situated at Bulevardul Mamaia 124, Constanța 900527, Romania.

#### **Extracurricular and Leisure Opportunities**

Medical students can participate in various student organizations such as the international AIESEC, which runs more than 12 projects annually, offers 100 internships, and provides 250 leadership roles. The international student body at Ovidius exceeds 1,100, with approximately half coming from Europe and 40% from the Middle East. The most common countries represented are Israel, Greece, Turkey, and Moldova. Additionally, Ovidius University supports a broad research program across all departments. Medical students have the chance to engage in impactful research projects that can advance their careers. Facilities such as the Center for Cancer Research, the Institute for Nanotechnologies, and various research centers in humanities and applied sciences provide students with opportunities to work on cutting-edge topics. For sports enthusiasts, the university offers numerous options including aerobics, athletics, badminton, basketball, bodybuilding, canoeing, dance, fitness yoga, football, jogging, modern gymnastics, martial arts, skiing, swimming, table tennis, tennis, and volleyball.

### Admission Process 2024–2025: Ovidius University Constanta

> Application:

To apply for an MBBS program, you must provide scanned copies of your 10th and 12th grade mark sheets along with a valid passport. These documents are mandatory for initiating the application process.

Required Documents:

Applicants must also submit a valid Transfer Certificate, Character Certificate, and Birth Certificate, all of which must be attached to the application.

> Verification:

After submission, your documents will be verified by the university. Based on this review, the university will either approve or reject your application. If approved, you will receive an official Letter of Acceptance as per university policy.

> NEET Requirement:

Indian students must provide a valid NEET score to be eligible for admission.

➤ Fees:

Once your application is accepted, an initial admission fee must be paid. In some cases, the university may request a bank statement showing a minimum balance for the past three months to confirm financial stability.

Visa Process:

After completing the steps above, students must apply for a student visa to pursue MBBS in Romania. For more information, visit MBBS in Romania.

### **Eligibility Criteria: Ovidius University Constanta**

> Criteria

NEET score is mandatory to study MBBS in Grigore T. Popa University of Medicine and Pharmacy.

➤ Academic

Required a minimum of 60% marks in your 10+2 level exam with PCB and in English

> Age Required

Your age should be 17 years on or before 31st December in the time of MBBS admission.
