Eligibility Criteria for studying MBBS in the University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Carol Davila

- Eligibility Criteria: Applicants must have completed their 12th grade with Biology, Physics, and Chemistry as mandatory subjects, securing a minimum of 60% marks.
- Entrance Examination: The university conducts an online entrance test primarily focused on Biology. Upon passing the test, candidates must also successfully complete an interview conducted in English to secure admission.
- English Language Proficiency: Students can present any internationally accepted English proficiency certificate like IELTS or TOEFL, or a Medium of Instruction (MOI) certificate from their previous institution, confirming at least B2 level English proficiency. Alternatively, the university offers an affordable English proficiency exam for admission purposes.

- Required Documents: Applicants need to submit essential documents such as a valid passport, national ID, 4–5 passport-sized photographs, a statement of purpose, a medical fitness certificate, and their high school academic records
- Application Timeline: The application process, including form submission, document verification, entrance exams, and interviews, typically takes place between April and September.

Admission Process in Transilvania University of Braşov

1. Online Form Submission

Complete the application form available online, ensuring all required details are provided, including a valid email address.

2. Application Fee

Make the payment for the registration or admission fee. Please note that this fee is non-refundable.

3. Document Submission

Provide the necessary documents, usually as original and certified copies. Certified translations may be required if documents are not in the official language:

High school diploma and academic transcript

Bachelor's degree certificate and transcript (if applicable)

English language proficiency proof (if required)

Official ACT or SAT scores (may not be required for some programs)

Additional program-specific materials (such as practical assessments, special exams, or a dissertation)

4. Specific Program Requirements

Doctoral Programs: A minimum GPA of 7 in both undergraduate and graduate studies is required, or other qualifications may apply based on national/international competition results.

Faculties with Entrance Exams: Programs such as Medicine, Music, and Psychology may involve written or practical entrance exams.

5. Document Delivery

Upload or send your documents via the university's official application portal or as directed by the institution.

6. Application Review

Your application and supporting documents will be reviewed by the university.

7. Admission Results

Initial admission decisions for most ends programs will be published on the university's website once the application period
