

Kazakh National Medical University



Kazakh National Medical University, founded in 1931 in a rural area of Almaty city, offers a 6-year MBBS program in Kazakhstan taught in English. The annual tuition fee is \$6,300, while hostel accommodation costs \$700 per year. Indian students can expect monthly living expenses of approximately \$100–120. Admission to the university is based on NEET exam scores. In 2024, the university had an FMGE passing rate of 4.76%. Applications for its courses are open until 15 July 2025. Kazakh National Medical University is known for its advanced medical training facilities, modern infrastructure, and strong collaborations with global institutions.

In 2024, S.D. Asfendiyarov Kazakh National Medical University (KazNMU) organized a series of significant events that underscored its commitment to medical education, research, and international collaboration. Among these was the XXV International Scientific and Practical Conference on "Actual Problems

of Clinical, Experimental Neurology, Neurosurgery, and Neurophysiology," held in July to commemorate the 90th anniversary of the Department of Nervous Diseases. This event attracted experts from Kazakhstan and abroad, facilitating discussions on rare diseases, neurorehabilitation, and advancements in neurology.

In April, the university hosted the "Job Fair 2024," connecting graduates with over 20 organizations, including prominent pharmaceutical companies like OtarBioPharm LLP. This initiative aimed to bridge the gap between academia and industry, providing students with employment opportunities. Director of ICD attended the event and gave students an inspiring speech, encouraging them to embrace global perspectives, develop their creative potential, and take an active role in international academic and cultural exchanges.

Admission Process

To apply to Kazakh National Medical University, candidates must complete an online application and upload scanned copies of their documents. Additionally, students need to obtain a visa to study in Kazakhstan and complete the enrollment process at the university.

Kazakh National Medical University: Eligibility Criteria

The eligibility requirements for admission to Kazakh National Medical University are as follows:

- Qualification: Completion of 12th grade with at least 50% marks in the Biology stream.
- Entrance Exam: NEET UG
- Age Limit: Must be at least 17 years old in the admission year.
- Language: Proficiency in English

Kazakh National Medical University: Required Documents

All student documents must be authenticated by the Ministry of External Affairs and the Kazakhstan Embassy. The following documents are necessary for admission:

- 10th and 12th-grade mark sheets
- NEET scorecard
- Valid passport
- Visa fees payment receipt
- Proof of payment for the first-year tuition fee
