North Kazakhstan State University has modern facilities, including advanced laboratories, libraries, and student accommodations. In 2024, North Kazakhstan University (NKU) actively engaged in various holiday programs aimed at enhancing student development and fostering international collaboration. One notable initiative was the university's participation in the Enactus Kazakhstan Business Summer Camp 2024, held at D. Serikbayev East Kazakhstan Technical University. This event brought together students from multiple institutions, including NKU, to collaborate on entrepreneurial projects,

develop business acumen, and engage in leadership training. The camp provided a platform for students to work on real-world business challenges, promoting innovation and teamwork among participants.

Additionally, NKU facilitated opportunities for its students to participate in international summer programs. For instance, the university encouraged eligible students to apply for the Summer Camp Program organized by the Kazakhstan Branch Campus of Northwestern Polytechnical University (NPU) in Xi'an, China. Scheduled from June 16 to 29, 2024, this two-week program offered professional lectures, Chinese language and culture courses, and visits to advanced enterprises and cultural attractions. The program aimed to provide participants with a deeper understanding of their respective majors and firsthand experience of Chinese culture. Notably, all costs for the program were covered by NPU, making it an accessible opportunity for NKU students. The Director of the Institute for Career Development wished everyone a happy and safe Holi and highlighted the importance of such cultural events in promoting diversity, inclusion, and student well-being.

Admission Process

To apply for the MBBS program at North Kazakhstan State University (NKSU) in Kazakhstan, you must first fill out the application form available on the university's official website. Next, submit all the required documents to complete your application. Once you receive the admission letter, you can proceed to apply for a student visa by providing your passport and other necessary paperwork. Finally, you need to travel to Kazakhstan to begin your medical studies.

North Kazakhstan State University: Eligibility Criteria

The following are the eligibility requirements for admission to North Kazakhstan State University:

- Students must be at least 17 years old on or before December 31 of the admission year.
- General category students should have scored a minimum of 50% in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) subjects in their 10+2 exams.
- Reserved category students must have secured at least 40% in PCB subjects in 10+2.
- All students must appear for the NEET 2025 examination.

North Kazakhstan State University: Documents Required

- Admission form
- Class 12th Pass Certificate/Mark sheet
- Class 10th Pass Certificate
- Scanned copy of Passport (first and last page)
- ID Proof (Adhar, PAN, Driving License, etc.) if the Passport is not ready at the time of application.
- NEET Result/Admit Card.
- Medical report with HIV report at the time of Visa stamping.
