

Karaganda State Medical University



Established in 1950, Karaganda State Medical University is recognized as one of the leading MBBS universities in Kazakhstan. It is a popular choice for students pursuing MBBS in Kazakhstan and holds accreditation from both the NMC and WHO. The annual tuition fee for MBBS at KSMU is \$4,100, making it an affordable option for many students. The university ranks 21st nationally and 6546th globally. Karaganda State Medical University has modern facilities, including advanced laboratories, libraries, and student accommodations. Karaganda State Medical University currently has over 8,000 students enrolled in different courses, including MBBS. Admissions for 2025 are anticipated to start in September. According to the Karaganda State Medical University FMGE report 2022, the university achieved a passing rate of 33.33%. In 2024, Karaganda Medical University hosted a variety of festivals that celebrated cultural diversity, promoted health awareness, and fostered community engagement among its students. One of the notable events was the Navratri celebration, a vibrant festival traditionally observed in India. The university's international students organized

Admission Process

To enroll in the MBBS program at KSMU in Kazakhstan, you need to apply either through the university's official website or via an authorized agent.

Within a few weeks, you will receive an admission letter from the university.

Once you have the admission letter, you should apply for a visa and book your flight ticket. Finally, you will travel to Kazakhstan to begin your medical studies.

Karaganda State Medical University: Eligibility Criteria

The following are the eligibility requirements for admission to Karaganda State Medical University:

- The student must be at least 17 years old on or before December 31 of the admission year.
- General category students should have scored a minimum of 50% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) in their 10+2 examination.
- Reserved category students must have at least 40% marks in PCB subjects in 10+2.
- All students must appear for the NEET 2025 exam.

- 10th-grade mark sheet
- 12th-grade mark sheet
- NEET scorecard
- 10 passport-sized photographs

- Authentication of all documents by the Ministry of External Affairs, New Delhi
- Legalization of all documents by the Kazakhstan Embassy
- Visa fees
- Bank receipt for the first-year tuition fees of Buryat State University (required by some universities)
- Official invitation letter from the university
- Medical examination report
- Official invitation letter from the Medical University of Kazakhstan
