Admission Process

Admission to the MBBS program at Kokshetau State University depends on several factors, including academic performance, English proficiency, and sometimes entrance exams. Candidates must have completed 10+2 with at least 62% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB). For university entrance exams, candidates need to score a minimum of 50% in Biology and

Chemistry. The minimum age requirement is 17 years, or the candidate must turn 17 by December 31 of the admission year. Indian students must have cleared 10+2 with at least 50% aggregate marks (40% for SC/ST/OBC) and must pass the NEET exam.

All Admission procedures will be guided by ICD

Kokshetau State University: Eligibility Criteria

The eligibility requirements for admission are:

- ➤ Pass 10+2 with at least 50% aggregate marks in PCB (40% for SC/ST/OBC)
- Qualify the NEET exam
- Demonstrate English proficiency
- ➤ Be at least 17 years old by December 31 of the admission year
- > Submit all required documents
- ➤ Hold a valid visa

Kokshetau State University: Documents Required

Applicants must provide the following documents:

- ➤ 10th and 12th-grade mark sheets
- > Transfer certificate
- ➤ 10 passport-sized photographs
- Migration certificate
- ➤ Birth certificate
- > Passport (valid for at least 18 months)
- ➤ Official invitation letter from the Medical University of Bulgaria
- ➤ Visa fee payment receipt
- > HIV test report
