Riga Stradins University



Riga Stradins University (RSU) is a publicly funded institution that offers a 5-year MBBS program. As a state-supported university, it provides high-quality medical education aligned with global standards. Riga Stradins stands out as the only university in Latvia that is traditionally integrated into the national healthcare system, playing a key role in its efficient operation. The university fosters a comprehensive learning environment, emphasizing hands-on experience through extensive clinical exposure. Students have the chance to gain practical knowledge during internships at RSU-affiliated hospitals and major medical centers such as P. Stradins Clinical University Hospital, the Children's Clinical University Hospital, and the Hospital of Traumatology and Orthopedics. Riga Stradiņš University has a strong international presence, with over 3,050 international students from more than 70 countries.

In 2024, Rīga Stradiņš University (RSU) hosted a series of significant academic events, underscoring its dedication to research, education, and international collaboration.

On March 21–22, RSU held its 10th International Student Conference in Health and Social Sciences, attracting over 3,000 participants from 17 countries. The conference featured 381 student research submissions across oral, poster, and case report sessions. Keynote speeches addressed topics such as the role of physical activity in treating type 2 diabetes and transparency within the European Union. Workshops, plenary sessions on climate change and military medicine, and a Clinical Case competition enriched the program. The event concluded with awards for outstanding research presentations and a performance by musician Chris Noah.

From June 17–21, RSU's Faculty of Public Health and Social Welfare organized the International Summer School 2024, focusing on data analysis, modeling, and simulation in healthcare. The intensive program included lectures by international experts, practical workshops, and case study-based group work, providing participants with hands-on experience in health management methodologies. **The Director of ICD** also attended the event and expressed strong support for the development of international academic standards and student success.

Eligibility: Riga University

1. Educational Background:

Applicants must have completed secondary education or an equivalent qualification, typically involving 12 years of formal schooling.

2. Required Subjects:

A strong academic foundation in science—particularly Physics, Chemistry, and Biology—is essential. Some institutions may also expect candidates to have studied Mathematics.

3. English Proficiency:

Since MBBS programs in Latvia are often taught in English, applicants must demonstrate proficiency through standardized tests like TOEFL or IELTS.

4. Entrance Examination (If Required):

Certain universities may conduct entrance exams to evaluate the candidate's aptitude for medical studies.

5. Academic Performance:

Applicants must meet the minimum grade requirements, especially in core science subjects, to qualify for admission.

6. Statement of Purpose (SOP):

Some universities request a written SOP outlining the applicant's motivation for studying medicine, long-term goals, and reasons for choosing the particular institution.

7. Letters of Recommendation:

Candidates may be asked to submit recommendation letters from teachers or academic mentors who can vouch for their academic capability and readiness for medical education.

8. Personal Interview (If Applicable):

As part of the selection process, some universities might conduct interviews to assess the applicant's passion for medicine, communication skills, and overall suitability for the program.

Documents Required: Riga University

- You must provide your Class 10th and Class 12th mark sheets and certificates when applying for an MBBS in Latvia.
- Additionally, you need to submit your migration certificate, admit card, and self-attested copies of all relevant documents for admission.
- A valid passport and student visa are required for studying MBBS in Latvia.
- The passport should be valid for at least five years from the date of issue and must be stamped by the Ministry of External Affairs.
- ➤ Information about your parents' financial status and proof of payment for the course fees must be submitted.
- ➤ Any other documents requested by the Latvian Ministry of External Affairs or the university must also be provided.
- ➤ A police-issued certificate confirming no criminal record is also necessary.

Admission Process: Riga University

- ➤ Step 1: Select a University

 Start by researching and shortlisting top NMC-approved medical universities in Latvia that offer MBBS programs in English.
- ➤ Step 2: Complete the Application Form

 Fill out the university's online application form with accurate personal and academic details.
- Step 3: Upload Required Documents
 Submit scanned copies of essential documents, including your Class 10 and 12 mark sheets, passport, NEET scorecard, and passport-sized photos.
- ➤ Step 4: Receive the Offer Letter

 Once your documents are verified, the university will issue a provisional admission (offer) letter.
- Step 5: Pay Initial Tuition Fees
 Pay the tuition fees specified in the offer letter to confirm your admission.
- ➤ Step 6: Apply for a Student Visa

 Use your offer letter and fee payment receipt to apply for a Latvian student visa through the appropriate embassy or consulate.
- ➤ Step 7: Book Travel and Prepare Documents

 After visa approval, book your flight to Latvia and ensure you have all required documents ready for your journey.
- Step 8: Join the University
 Upon arrival, report to the university, complete the registration process.
