Admission Process

The MD admission process at Gdansk Medical University depends on multiple factors such as academic results, English language skills, and occasionally entrance exam scores. Applicants must have completed 10+2 education with the required minimum aggregate, including either two of the four core subjects or three (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology). Candidates applying for the medicine program should hold a foreign high school diploma. Strong knowledge in biology and chemistry is essential since the entrance exam, conducted in English, consists of a written test and a qualifying interview.

Gdansk Medical University: Eligibility Criteria

- ➤ The eligibility requirements for admission to Gdansk Medical University include:
- ➤ Valid English proficiency certificates like CAE, CPE, TOEFL IBT (at least 75 points), or IELTS (minimum 6.0).
- Possession of a foreign high school diploma.
- ➤ Appearance for the entrance exam covering two subjects: Physics and Chemistry.
- Academic grades must be above average.
- ➤ Knowledge assessment through the MS Teams entrance examination.
- > Proficiency in English language.

Gdansk Medical University: Required Documents

Applicants must submit the following documents to Gdansk Medical University:

- ➤ Completed application form for the diploma.
- > Academic transcript or record of studies.
- > Statement of eligibility.
- > Criminal record certificate.
- > Proof of English language proficiency.
- ➤ Hepatitis B vaccination certificate.
- ➤ Valid passport.
- > Two passport-sized photographs.
- > Official Polish translation of documents.
- ➤ Apostille and legalization certificates.
- > Recognition certificate from the Department of Education.
