

Medical University of Lublin



The Medical University of Lublin was established on October 24, 1949, following a decree by the cabinet. The university provides education in general medicine, pharmacy, and health sciences for both graduate and doctoral students. Additionally, students are encouraged to participate in training programs conducted at public research centers. Currently, the university has 7,000 students, including 1,000 international students from 53 different countries. The Medical University of Lublin offers specialization programs in fields such as medical analytics, biomedicine, physiotherapy, pharmacy, dental hygiene, dentistry, nursing, emergency medicine, and public health. The programs at the Medical University of Lublin are approved by the Central Council for Science and Higher Education of Poland. The Medical Academy Lublin Library was founded in the year 2000 at 18 Szkolna Street.

The Medical University of Lublin in Poland offers a wide range of specialized programs designed to prepare students for diverse careers in health sciences. Among these programs are medical analytics, biomedicine, physiotherapy, pharmacy, dental hygiene, dentistry, nursing, emergency medicine, and public health.

The university's curriculum is carefully approved by the Central Council for Science and Higher Education of Poland, ensuring high academic standards. Students at the Medical University of Lublin also benefit from opportunities to engage in practical training at public research centers, enhancing their professional skills and experience. Admissions Process

Here is a simplified guide for international students applying to the university:

- Submit your application through the university's official website using the online application form.
- Provide the necessary academic documents along with your NEET score.
- If required, complete an interview or entrance test successfully.
- Pay the enrollment fees and receive your offer letter.
- Apply for a Polish student visa and then travel to the university.

Medical University of Lublin: Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be at least 17 years old at the time of admission.
- Students should have a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) in their 10+2 education.
- Indian students need to have qualified the NEET exam.
- Proof of English proficiency through IELTS or TOEFL is mandatory.

Medical University of Lublin: Required Documents

- Mark sheets for 10th and 12th grades
- Valid NEET scorecard
- Passport valid for at least 18 months
- Birth certificate
- Passport-sized photos
- Medical fitness certificate
- Police clearance certificate
- English language proficiency certificate (IELTS or TOEFL)
- Official offer letter from the university
- Visa application and approval documents
