- Completion of 10+2 education from a recognized board.
- Subjects must include Biology, Physics, and Chemistry.
- Minimum 65% aggregate in 12th grade.
- Applicant must be 17 years or older by December 31 of the admission year.
- NEET qualification is mandatory.
